The Lucas County LEPC will be presenting a three day CAMEO course, which covers CAMEO, MARPLOT and ALOHA. Instruction and course materials are provided free of charge. Students will receive a copy of the software, user manuals, and a Certificate of Completion. Course location and instructors:

CAMEO: Computer Aided Management of Emergency Operations

- Allows users to store records for Schools, Routes, Chemicals, Emergency Contacts, and facility Information.
- Provides a Chemical Library with information on over 6000 chemicals
- Allows users to predict chemical reactions and perform chemical release scenarios.

MARPLOT: Mapping Applications for Response, Planning, and Local Operational Tasks

- Basic Mapping/GIS Program
- Allows users to create personal layers and display areas of importance on a map
- Works interchangeably with CAMEO and ALOHA

ALOHA: Areal Locations of Hazardous Atmospheres

- Program allows users to run scenarios for airborne chemicals
- Runs analysis based on geographic location, topography, meteorological conditions, chemical characteristics and quantity of material released
- Can make predictions for tank, puddle, pipeline, and direct releases within the limitations of the software
- Models toxic vapor, burning product (pool fire), or boiling liquid expanding vapor explosion (BLEVE).
