\* This will be charged as a one time flat rate for use of equipment, but not to include replacement cost of used, damaged, destroyed, or disposal of any equipment.

\*\* Flat rate for first hour of part thereof. \$25 / hr. for each hour after the first hour not to exceed \$500.00/day for duration of each incident.

**\*\*\* Damaged Equipment**

The cost of repair of the equipment to its condition prior to the incident will be billed to the responsible party. Exception - when the cost of repair exceeds 75% of the current value of the equipment, total replacement cost will be billed to the responsible party.

**Destroyed or expended equipment, clothing, supplies, etc.**

Current cost of replacement will be billed to the responsible party.

**NOTES:**

- 1 All fees for apparatus, vehicles, and mobile equipment to include fuel necessary to operate for duration of incident.
- 2 All hourly rate fees will be charged at even hours. Any fractions of parts thereof will be charged at the next hours time (e.g. 1-1/4 hr. will be charged at 2 hours actual time).
- 3 Any individual that is transported by the Lucas County EMS to a medical facility will be charged the current base rate plus any applicable supplies.
- 4 All fees on materials, apparatus, and manpower are subject to change without notice.
